SB1176 WET RECKLESS DRIVING PROGRAM FACT SHEET

The SB1176 program is designed to be a 45 day to 90 day Outpatient Alcohol/Drug Education Program, consisting of 15 hours of curriculum in our facility at approximately 1.5 to 3 hours of involvement per week.

INTAKE/EVALUATION APPOINTMENT

Intake/Evaluation appointment is a scheduled, 45-minute appointment to evaluate your treatment needs and to schedule your curriculum. **(SB1176 program does not have verification of enrollment forms for the DMV as it is a court ordered and not recognized by the DMV).**

- 1 - Individual Counseling Sessions(Total of 15 Min.)
- 10 - Alcohol/Drug-awareness Classes.....(Total of 15 Hours)

FEE SCHEDULE:

The total fee for the SB1176 Program is \$240.00. (Suggested fee schedule is \$120.00 down at intake and \$120.00 due by completion.) No client has ever been refused an intake appointment due to lack of funds. Any alterations in the fee or fee schedule must be discussed with the Program Director.

NOTE: Program length will be approximately 45-90 days and **TOTAL ABSTINENCE** is required during this time.

Also, this program is court ordered and is not recognized by the DMV to meet the restricted license requirements under the Admin Per Se Law. The DMV may request the enrollment and completion of the AB541 (three-month first offender program) to obtain a restricted license if the blood alcohol concentration (BAC) is .08 or higher at the time of the arrest. The SB1176 program has no verification of enrollment form or completion form for the DMV. These forms are only available for the AB541 program.
